**DOG FIGHTING PARAPHERNALIA???**

**OR SOMETHING MORE INNOCENT...**  
Supposedly owning or possessing certain items makes you a dog fighter... here are a few items and what they are used for and why them being labeled "paraphernalia" doesn't make you or anyone else a dog fighter...

*Slat mill/carpet mill/e-mill: These are all great ways to exercise your dogs, they are often times used by the owners of high energy breeds or owners that live in areas with harsh climates at certain times of the year, and example would be the harsh winters or extremely hot summers where exercising your dogs outdoors isn't an option. The slat mill and carpet mills are both dog powered mills, meaning the dog controls the mill, if the dog stops running the mill stops. Electric mills are like the ones a human walks on, they are great to use as well, but being that they aren't dog powered you have to pace the dog using the controls so they don't over work themselves, all mills need 100% owner supervision at all times. Often times you'll see the dogs attached to the mill using a leash, or chain that is attached to the collar. This is NOT to "force" the dog to run, this is to keep the dog safe and keep it from running off the front of the mill and hurting itself. Another comment made on mills, "why don't you get off your ass and walk your dog?!!" Anyone that owns a high energy or working breed of dog knows how silly that sounds. You could walk all day with a dog like that and still never get it tired. The mills are tools to help properly exercise your dog and keep them healthy physically as well as mentally, because a bored or unworked high energy dog is not something anyone wants!*
