Directions.

Not recommended for use in puppies under 6 months of age.

Stir the jar of local honey or the product HoneyCure before use.

Spread a thin layer on the injured area, making sure to completely cover the wound including about half an inch of healthy skin around it.

Since HoneyCure acts as an insect repellent and discourages licking - then wrapping is not necessary but is recommended.

With pure local honey wrapping is needed to keep bees and insects away.

If the wound can be covered, use a medical dressing to provide an additional barrier.

Repeat the treatment every 1 – 3 days.
