1. Introduction to sensible solution for dangerous or potentially dangerous dogs.

In the light of possible banning the APBT Bulldog breed.

Looking at a workable policy and model legislative framework of how to prevent dog attacks on humans and animals in the community.

It all has, and or will begin with you, your dog, in or on your yard/premises - for the safety of your dog, any other humans and or animals.

The starting point >>> no dog should be free roaming the streets, (Moreso no APBT Bulldog) - never to be allowed) free to run free outside the safety confinement of your yard or premises.

Don't walk your APBT Bulldog in public – find safe place with no dogs or animals - away from people, children, or animals (especially other dogs) – know that your dog's doings are your responsibility and accountability.

The golden rule >>> if it is not your intention to have a human aggressive protection, APBT Bulldog as an attack, guard or watch dog (then knowingly harboring such a dog as a dangerous animal with the

potential to be just that, **then never teach this dog – to be human aggressive** - or allow your pups or any of your dogs to chase children or humans or allow children and humans to chase or tease **your** APBT Bulldog or train the dog as an attack dog.

Start here >>> get your APBT Bulldog or pups and dogs use to the collar, the leach, the harness, and the mussel **before any other training** – even and more so in your yard and in your house. There must be a reason for you having such a dog in the first place.

Dogs have been and will specifically be kept by humans for various reasons – mostly as pet dogs and or companion dogs or as family dogs.

Then by "some" and by choice as guard and watch dogs, also by "some" specifically as attack and protection dogs (and trained to be just that) or trained for whatever other reason and individual needs a dog.

Know this >>> different breeds for different needs.

Realizing the purpose of having and keeping a dog or dogs varies on the individual owners need of having the dog or dogs in the first place – every need will be individual, the same as that every individual dog breed was created and selectively bred-for a purpose and every different dog breed will be an individual.

No puppy or dog was born equal and then needs to be evaluated as an individual for what they can do – and or were genetically and selectively bred for.

Then never to forget >>> dogs are animals - not humans.

<u>John Holmes said</u>>>> "A dog is not "almost human, and I know of no greater insult to the canine race than to describe it as such."

<u>With APBT Bulldogs</u> >>>that which can be destroyed by the truth, should be - and this should be <u>your goal as APBT Bulldog breeder and or dog owner.</u>

Leach control – safe boundary – escape proof yard or kennel.

You the dog owner of any dog, **and more so if keeping an APBT Bulldog**, should know that <u>your APBT Bulldog need to be always on a leach and always in and under your control – hands on control – every time – again every time - and more so in any and every situation and circumstance inside and outside **your** yard.</u>

This is not nuclear science ... just common sense ... your dogs should also be safe in your yard – it becomes your responsibility and accountability for any of your dog's actions - and you should never allow your dogs or allow anyone in your household to let your dog out or allow them roam freely in the streets.

It is **your** responsibility to accommodate and humanely confine **your** dog safely in **your** escape proof yard.

Realizing individual dogs with bad temperament cannot and must not roam free in the streets or ever have the opportunity to get out of **your** yard.

Owners with a bad-tempered dog (**you** will know) must ensure escape proof housing or safe confinement best suited for the specific dog **and keep such dog safe in your yard.**

Coller, leach, and muzzle the dog.

Whenever **you** walk **your** dog ... any dog ... outside **your** yard – always on leash control on a solid safe collar – that's the law – if needed muzzle the dog – **you** have no excuse.
